1.	A	Enter in medium walk, proceed down centre line without halting	10
2.	C CH	Track left Medium walk	10
3.	HEKA	Working trot	10
4.	A AX	Medium walk Half circle left 20m diameter	10
5.	X	Halt, immobility 5 seconds (leader change sides) proceed in medium walk	10
6	XC CM	Half circle right 20m diameter Medium walk	10
7	MBFA	Working trot	10
8.	A AX	Medium walk Half circle right 20m diameter	10
9.	X	Halt, immobility 5 seconds (leader change sides) proceed in medium walk	10
10	XC CH	Half circle left 20m diameter Medium walk	10
11	HEK	Walk allowing the horse to stretch on a longer rein	10 x 2
12	KA	Medium walk	10
13	A	Turn left up centre line towards X	10

### Collective Marks

1.	Paces (freedom and regularity)	10
2.	Submission way of going (attention and confidence, ease of movements, acceptance of bridle)	10
3.	Skill and accuracy of rider	10 x 2
4.	Skill of the leader, promoting independence of the rider throughout the test, without intervention	10

The leader should have minimal influence on the pony/horse or rider. The amount of influence will be reflected in the marks. One mark will be deducted from the movement score on each occasion that the leader is seen to influence the horse/pony. The leader should lead from the inside, changing sides in front of the pony at the halt movement.
